Pond and Water Conservation Campaign in Shankargarh and Bundelkhand region of Uttar Pradesh, Efforts have been made for Water Conservation and for Promotion since 2011. Organizing 'Gaanv Gaanv Paani Chaupal', 'Paani Panchayat', 'Nadi Sansad' for the Conservation and Promotion of Natural Sources of Water, Ponds and Small Rivers.

To form 'Jal Mitra' and 'Jal Saheli' in the village to ensure the sustainability of the water projects undertaken in the villages.

Organized the revival of Ponds and Rivers through collective cooperation and means of labour practice of the village at Gram Panchayat level itself.

- 1. **Renovation of 75 ponds** has been done so far across the entire Bundelkhand through collaborative effort of labour donation (*Shram Daan*).

- 2. With the help of **NITI Aayog**, **Arunodaya Foundation Mahoba**, **ATE Chandra Foundation** and the district administration, **23 ponds have been renovated** under Gaurihar block in Chhatarpur district.
- 3. **45 ponds have been renovated** under our own supervision with the help of **MNREGA**. These sites are located across the Bundelkhand region and the Prayagraj district.
- 4. The work of constructing 3 ponds in 3 fields was done under the **Farm Pond Scheme in the Banda district.**
- 5. With the help of the District administration of Prayagraj, Banda and Chitrakoot **encroachments** have been effectively removed from 10 ponds, restoring their natural state.
- 6. Over the past five years, we have dedicated our efforts to the Conservation and Promotion of 'Maa Mandakini' of the Ganga in the Chitrakoot district of Bundelkhand. (Click here)

- 7. The river (Baan Ganga), a tributary of the Bagai river, which was in an extinct state, has returned in the same form after 5 years of struggle.
- 8. **Inspired by** the concept of **Mangal Gram, by Nanaji Deshmukh,** people centric development focused on bringing prosperity to the village is being practiced in Andhav Marka of Banda, Thurat of Mahoba district, Jhalokhar of Hamirpur, Gahbra of Chhatarpur, Sonvarsha of Shankargarh area of Prayagraj, Chilla Gauhani, Pachkhara, Mohanpur (Khandeha) of Chitrakoot district.
- 9. The promotion of cow-based natural farming has commenced in seven villages of Bundelkhand, aligning with the Mangal Gram village concept.

- 10. Under the Mission 'Khet ka Paani Khet me, Gaanv ka Paani Gaanv me' a village campaign for the construction of farm embankments was done in the andhava village of Banda district. (Link) This campaign received the appreciation by the honorable Prime Minister in his popular 'Mann Ki Baat' episode dated 27 June 2021.
